Appreciation Week Recognizes Arizona Water Professionals

PHOENIX – During the week of April 14-20 Arizonans will honor the hard work of professionals in the water industry during the inaugural Arizona Water Professionals Appreciation Week. The week has been officially recognized through House Resolution 2002. The resolution, sponsored by Rep. Rosanna Gabaldon (D-Sahuarita), is scheduled to be read on the floor of the House of Representatives on April 15 (time not yet announced).

This recognition program was started by professionals who work in Arizona's water industry to spotlight their role in promoting clean and sustainable water supplies, drawing attention to career opportunities in the water industry, and increasing awareness of Arizona's unique water resources.

Thousands of professionals work in water-related fields in Arizona, and new employees are needed each year due to growth in the industry and to replace an aging workforce. The water industry offers a wide variety of rewarding career opportunities in engineering, hydrology, water operations, biology, policy, economics, business administration, law, and communications.
